

Since the 1970s, Austrian photographer Alfred Seiland has traveled across Europe and the U.S., focusing his large-format camera on everyday rural life.

Some 25 of his eloquently deadpan documentary images are on view at the gallery Kicken Berlin through November 27, priced from €1,800 (\$2,000) to €14,800 (\$17,000). The works were previously published
